Learning objectives

Subject: Science & food education.

Pupils will:

- Identify and name a range of farm animals.
- Find out about different breeds of farm animals.
- Find out about what different farm animals eat and what their care needs are.
- Find out how to handle and care for small animals.
- Learn outside the classroom on a working farm.
- Be actively involved with 'hands on' activities with the opportunities to ask questions to aid learning.
